Gathering Accommodation:

Tatum Park has

- single rooms (13 available)
- double rooms (16 available)
- twin rooms (15 available)

Please let us know if you wish to be in a single, double, or twin room. These rooms will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

The Lodge Accommodation at Tatum Park has bedding and linen supplied and is serviced daily. The Lodge is carpeted, heated, and have hand-basins with hot water in each room. There are ample communal toilets and showers, including one wheelchair access bathroom.

Wheelchair access: There is wheelchair access at Tatum Park, except for the Conference Room, which is upstairs.

Campervans:

Tatum Park has powered Campervan hook-ups. If you wish to bring your own Campervan, please book the space directly with Tatum Park. Cost: \$17.00 per person per night.

Transport to venue:

By Intercity Bus: If you use this service, please let us know and we will arrange a pickup from Otaki.

By Air: Into Palmerston North

- We can only arrange for a Shuttle van from and to one airport.
- There is a flight from Auckland that arrives at 4.35 p.m. and we can arrange a 11-seater Shuttle van to take you from PMN airport to Tatum Park. Return cost of van is: \$364.00 approx.
- This cost would be shared among the number of people who wish to use this service.
- This would also mean you will arrive at Tatum Park in time for Dinner (6.30 p.m.) and the evening trip. Please pay Anthea McClelland for your share of transport costs on arrival at Tatum Park.
- Please let us know if you wish to use the Shuttle van when you register for the Gathering.
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PLEASE NOTE: Flights from Auckland to Wellington are more frequent, **but** unless you are able to arrive in Wellington before 3.00pm. you will hit the rush hour you will not make in time for Dinner.

Saturday afternoon Trips:

So, we can have an even spread of participants on each trip, please would you state your preference in order of choice – 1, 2 or 3.

- **Trip 1:** A bird watching/beach walk on Waikawa Beach and hopefully see the gull colony.
- **Trip 2:** Lake Papaitonga: Papaitonga Scenic Reserve is an important refuge for birds that depend as forest species on the lake's margins. Within the reserve is the only intact sequence from wetland to mature dry terrace forest in Wellington and Horowhenua.
- **Trip 3:** Bush walk – ' Lets run a MicroBioBlitz' in a local Bush Reserve.

Car-pooling: As some of the participants at the Gathering will not have their own transport – or would prefer not to drive to the trip location. Please let us know if you have seats available to car-pool or wish to car pool with someone.

What to bring

- Good torch for night walk.
- Notebook and pen for taking notes.
- Walking shoes or boots, outdoor clothing to suit the conditions.
