“A World Apart; two islands in two oceans – Gough Island and Mana Island”

Speaker: Chris Bell, Conservationist

Chris Bell and his wife spent a year on Gough Island, **Tristan da Cunha** is the name of both a remote group of [volcanic islands](#) in the south [Atlantic Ocean](#) and the main island of that group. It is the [most remote](#) inhabited [archipelago](#) in the world, lying 2,000 kilometres (1,200 mi) from the nearest inhabited land.

And he is now DoC Ranger on Mana Island. Chris will talk about the conservation work and the differences and similarities between the two islands.
