Tunnel Vision



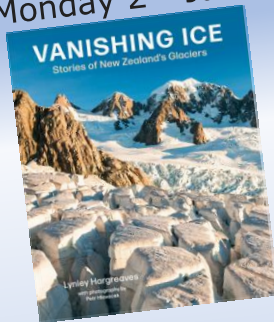
